VENUE DETAILS

Venue details for the Autumn Term remain the same:

• Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays – classes remain at St Mary's Church Hall. • Saturdays – All classes will take place at St Mary's School, Russell Road, Wimbledon, SW19 1QL. Parking is available at the school as long as it is prebooked via the 'Just Park' app. The school car park is accessed via Pelham Road. AUDITIONS

Please note that children who apply for dance auditions are requested to ask for consent from the school or they could lose their place.

APPLICATION DEADLINE & DISCOUNT

Please note that refunds are not available once classes have been booked. To qualify for the discount, applications must be received and payments cleared by Saturday, 12th July 2025.

We will not chase for payments - if not received by this date, we will assume you no longer require the place.

PLEASE READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!

As places are limited and **demand is increasing,** to ensure you have a place for next term please follow these simple steps.

- 1. Please make sure that standard and specialist classes are paid separately to standard discount classes and please read the timetable clearly so that you can work out what the costs are of the classes.
- 2. All payments should be received by Saturday 12th July 2025.

Any applications received after the deadline date (12th July 2025) may have the payment returned, and applicants automatically placed on to the waiting list. Applicants on the waiting list will be informed of the availability of places during the week before term starts. Fees will be higher and there will be no guarantee that there will be places available.

Ballet uniform from Grade 4 onwards-We are looking into new leotards and researching leotards that will not be discontinued in the future, so please do not buy any new leotards yet.

Modern-During normal class term times, the **seniors** can wear the pink footloose ballet tights as opposed to the black, as there is no time to change between classes, but for exams, they will need black footless tights. **Juniors** need to have the leotard, bare legs and bare foot during term time, but for exams they will need black footless tights.

Black convertible or footless tights should be worn for **Modern/ Contemporary.** Black convertible tights should be worn full-footed or regulation black dance socks worn with footless tights for **Tap**. **Nail varnish is not allowed.**

All classes that are missed must be paid for or places will be lost. Please note that specialist grades will now be charged at a fixed price no matter how many classes, like most institutions, as they are small classes and vocational. Please, therefore adjust prices accordingly. The difference in pricing reflects the number of pupils in the class, venue fee and the teacher taking the class. We reserve the right to adjust pricing if numbers in a class reduce at any point. We reserve the right to cancel or change class times at any point. NO refunds will be given.

- 1. Please note: extra classes, like examination or coaching classes must be paid for prior to the class.
- 2. Please note: Exams are not applicable to all pupils and Karen Forbes School of Dance reserves the right to withdraw and/or enter pupils at their discretion at any stage.
 - 3. Pupils undertaking ballet exams from Grade One upwards will need to attend two classes per week please note exams are not compulsory. 4. Please note there will be no refunds under any circumstances make up classes will be offered where necessary. 5. Children who miss class will not be able to make them up, unless by prior arrangement.
 - 6. Existing pupils please note that should their booking and payment not be presented by the closing date, their places will be lost. 7. Neither the school (Karen Forbes School of Dance) nor the hall will be liable for the loss or damage of any property belonging to the pupils. 8. Parents and Guardians of children under the age of five are requested to remain on the premises i.e. in the corridor or in the room, in case they are needed during class.
 - 9. As is the case in any dance class, physical contact from teachers with pupils is an essential part of the lesson in order to rectify posture. 10. If any unforeseen circumstances arise causing a class to be cancelled, a suitable alternative class will be arranged at the schools discretion and no refunds will be offered.
 - 11. Discounted prices are only available if classes are booked in advance by the appropriate date.
 - 12. Any student wishing to attend external auditions must obtain prior consent from Karen Forbes or they may lose their place in the school. 13. Karen Forbes School of Dance reserves the right to refuse application to pupils or remove pupils at the schools discretion. 14. If a pupil has an injury, even if sustained elsewhere, the school must be informed so that we can take appropriate precautions. 15.
